Due to the increase in numbers in the Group we have bought another tent and Go-Pak tables and benches for camping. The tent was funded by a donation from local councillors and we were able to purchase the tables and benches from the fundraising money from the two bag packs.

We also had a frame tent and kitchen items donated from a local resident which came in handy at St. George's camp enabling us to cook in a separate tent improving further the safety of all scouts on camp.

In addition to the large 1st aid kit from the Active Kids scheme we have purchased a small mobile kit for each of the four sections. This will ensure that when any of the children are away from the halls on any activity there is a suitable first aid pack available rather than relying on leader's personal kits.

We still store all our equipment in a local storage container which does allow all items to be correctly insured and under 24 hour security. However we are still on the lookout for a plot of land or building to develop as a scout hut.
