Subscriptions

All subscription fees should be paid each term directly to the Treasurer no later than the end of the first month of the term (30th Sept, 31st Jan, Easter date dependant on term dates for that year) This may be done via on-line banking, details of which are; HSBC, Sort Code 40-18-36, Account 91436139. For a reference they should quote their child's name and date of birth. Alternatively payments can be taken to the treasurer Nicola Beacham at 23 Marloes Path, Greenmeadow NP44 4SE. Please mark the back of the cheques "subs" and state the child's name.

Fees will be reduced for second and third children residing at the same address. Current rates in force are £35 for one child, £68 for two children and £99 for three children. New members will be given a period of grace when they join the Group to decide if Scouting is for them and subscriptions will not apply during this period. The maximum bedding in period will be six weeks. Pro-rata subscriptions will apply for any child remaining in the group after this period at a rate of £2.75 per week for each additional week if they joined part way through a term. If you are a tax payer please ensure you ask for a Gift Aid form which allows us to claim tax back on your subscriptions.

On leaving the Group (other than moving up to Explorers) it is the parent's responsibility to inform the Group that their child is leaving. If this notification is after the end of the first month of the term then full fees will be applicable for the term of leaving.
